The following rules have been established for the good of all exhibitors concerned. Failure to comply could result in an Event Committee action (Chapter 5, Section 2 of "Rules Applying To Registration and Discipline").

1. Plastic sheeting is to be placed under every crate in hotel rooms. This will keep carpets clean and dry. Plastic sheeting for each crate will be the responsibility of each exhibitor to provide his or her own.
2. **DOGS MUST BE CRATED WHEN OWNER IS OUT OF THE ROOM. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, WHILE IN THE HOTEL, LOBBIES, OR ON HOTEL GROUNDS. ROOMS AND LOBBY MUST BE KEPT CLEAN OF DOG DEBRIS.**
4. Dogs should be "exercised" in designated areas on motel premises. Every dog owner is expected to pick up after his or her own dog and dispose waste in designated trash cans. **It is the responsibility of the dog owner to find out from the innkeeper where these areas and cans are located.**
5. No dog may be bathed in the hotel due to severe drain pipe clogging problems.
6. Rooms may be inspected daily by members of the hotel management and/or the Investigative Committee.

From I-70, take I-270 South or from I-71, take I-270 East. Exit I-270 at Exit 49 (Alum Creek Drive). Go north approximately 1 mile on Alum Creek Drive and turn left on Williams Road (there is a traffic light at this intersection). Exhibitors—Please Note

1. A recording fee of \$0.50 and an event service fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Ch. 14, Section 2).
2. A recording fee of \$3.00 will be required for each class each dog is entered at any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. This fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fees are collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulations, Chapter 11, Section 3).
3. **Entries must be made on an official American Kennel Club form, and signed at the bottom by the owner or the owner's duly authorized agent;** otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. Telegraph, Telephone, and Fax entries cannot be accepted. Photocopies of the entry forms without the Agreement & Rules on the reverse side of the Official Entry form are not acceptable.
4. **Move-ups are permitted** in the Rally and Obedience trials provided the following conditions are met: (1) The dog completes the requirements for a title, according to the owner's records; (2) A request for a move-up is presented, in writing, to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Trial (see move-up form included in this premium list); and (3) The next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
5. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee.
6. Dogs must be ready for judging. **Judges will not wait for any dog.**
7. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practical after entries close. Contact the Trial Secretary if acknowledgement is not received.
8. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. In the situation of extreme weather conditions such as, but not limited to, heat, snowstorms, hurricanes, etc., the event may be cancelled.
9. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. **Please type or print carefully the information on entry forms to eliminate errors.**
10. Bitches in season won't be admitted to the Trial. Any Exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the Trial date, will be refunded the entry fee, less \$9.00 per class, per day, upon written certification by a Veterinarian, submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the Trial.
11. Entry fees **will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian, or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
12. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each check. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order BEFORE the dog will be allowed in the ring.
13. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (i.e., Novice to Open or Novice to Advanced) and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.
